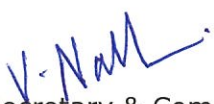

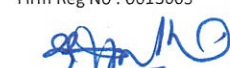

Notes to Financial Statements

1. The financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 have been subjected to review by the Statutory Auditors M/s. JAKS Associates Chartered Accountants. The financials result as on June 30, 2025 were also reviewed by M/s. JAKS Associates Chartered Accountants.
2. The Corporation has consistently applied its significant accounting policies in the preparation of quarterly financial results ended June 30, 2026 as compared to those followed for the year ended March 31, 2026.
3. The Portfolio of the Corporation as on June 30, 2026 is Rs. 8,21,880.22 Lakh comprising Standard Advances of Rs.7,93,617.77 Lakh, Substandard Advances of Rs.24,734.53 Lakh and Doubtful Advances of Rs.3527.91 Lakh.
4. The Corporation follows the policy of technical write off of advances in Doubtful category to maintain asset quality which is done at the end of the financial year. Hence no advances have been technically written off as on June 30, 2026. The advances in doubtful category as on June 30, 2026 amounts to Rs. 3527.91 Lakh.
5. In conformity with the prudential norms, provisions are given on the basis of classification of assets as prescribed by RBI. Provision for standard advances are made at such rates subject to the minimum provisioning prescribed by the RBI / SIDBI guidelines for standard advances. Provisions for bad and doubtful debts are made in respect of non-performing advances based on overall portfolio quality, asset growth, economic conditions, Management's assessment and other risk factors subject to the minimum provisioning level prescribed by the RBI / SIDBI guidelines.

During the period under review, the corporation has provided minimum provisions as prescribed by RBI for all advances. i.e. 0.25% for SME sector, 0.40% for Medium /Other sector and 1% for Commercial Real Estate (CRE) sector advances in accordance with the extant RBI IRAC norms and SIDBI guidelines and in respect of CRE sector standard assets covered under the Reserve Bank of India (Project Finance) Directions, 2025, provision has been maintained at 1.25% during the construction phase as prescribed under the said Directions. (same provisioning as on March 31,2026), 15% for substandard advances (77% as on March 31, 2026) and 25% for doubtful advances (Technically written off as on March 31,2026).

The Corporation has provided an additional provision of Rs. 1208.12 lakhs in respect of the 188 Standard loans with balance outstanding of Rs. 13947.63 lakhs as on 30.06.2026 which were restructured in accordance with the COVID 19 pandemic resolution framework prescribed by RBI for Micro, Small and Medium (MSME) as per RBI guidelines in F.Y 2020-21 and F.Y 2021-22 and Resolution framework for Covid-19 related stress as per RBI Circular dated May 5, 2021 (Resolution framework 2.0).

6. The minimum provision needed as on June, 2026 is Rs.8,877.86 Lakh and the total provision available for Bad and Doubtful debts / Other assets as on March



31, 2026 is Rs. 22,453.53 Lakh and hence no additional provision is made for the quarter ended June 30, 2026.

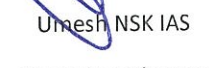
7. The Gross NPA and Net NPA as on June, 2026 are 3.44% and 1.25% respectively as against 2.32% and 0.43% as on March 31, 2026.
8. The calculation of deferred tax Asset/ Liability will be done on a yearly basis as per the policy of the Corporation.
9. During the quarter ended 30.06.2026, the Corporation has revised the classification of cash flow items in the Statement of Cash Flows to ensure compliance with the requirements of Accounting Standard (AS) 3 – Cash Flow Statements. Accordingly, Interest received on deposits/investments has been classified under Cash Flows from Operating Activities instead of Cash Flows from Investing Activities and Interest and other costs relating to Non-SLR Bonds have been classified under Cash Flows from Operating Activities instead of Cash Flows from Financing Activities. The corresponding comparative figures have also been restated to conform to the current period presentation. The above reclassification is only a presentation change and has no impact on the net increase/decrease in cash and cash equivalent balances, profit for the period, or the financial position of the Corporation.
10. The Corporation availed a total of Rs 2,07,435.46 Lakh as foreign currency loan from SBI for tenors not exceeding 180 days on a fully hedged basis. All transactions in foreign currency are recognized at the exchange rate prevailing on the date of the transaction. The premium amortised during the three months' ended June 30, 2026 is Rs 1,040.49 Lakh and the deferred premium as on June 30, 2026 is Rs. 1,261.58 Lakh. The notional forex-gain/Loss during the three months' ended June 30, 2026 is not recognized and will be done on a yearly basis as per the policy of the Corporation.
11. Previous period / year figures have been regrouped, wherever necessary to confirm the classification of the current period.

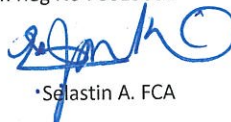

LIMITED REVIEW REPORT

The Board of Directors
Kerala Financial Corporation
Kanaka Nagar Vellayambalam
Thiruvananthapuram -695033

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of Kerala Financial Corporation for the three-month period ended 30.06.2026. This statement is the responsibility of the Corporation's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.
2. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 - "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain the moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
3. Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and other recognized accounting practices and policies has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement or that it has not been prepared in accordance with the relevant prudential norms issued by the Reserve Bank of India in respect of income recognition, asset classification, provisioning, and other related matters.



Emphasis Paragraph:

1. Notional foreign exchange gains or losses incurred during the three - month period ending on June 30, 2026, is not recognized and these gains or losses will be assessed and recognized on an annual basis, in accordance with the Corporation's established policy. (Reference to Note No. 10).
2. The calculation of deferred tax assets and liabilities is performed annually, so there has been no impact on the financials for the period ending June 30, 2026. (Reference to Note No.8).
3. We refer to **Note No. 5 & 6** , KFC creates minimum provision for standard assets, and for non-performing assets, provision is made in excess of RBI regulations at the end of Financial Year. However, during the period under review, KFC has not provided any additional provisions, since the provision created as of March 31, 2026, exceeds the minimum provisioning requirements for the three-month period ended June 30, 2026, prescribed by RBI.
4. The corporation has not technically written off any loans as bad debts as on June 30, 2026, which is only done at the year-end. The profit shown for the three-month period ended 30.06.2026 is subject to this adjustment. (Reference to Note-4).
5. The balance in suspense account as on 30.06.2026 amounting to Rs.580.86 Lakh includes Rs. 312.27 Lakh attributable to contractor loan which is identifiable. The balance in Suspense Account as on 31.07.2026 has come down to Rs.261.25 Lakh.
6. The Standard Asset portfolio includes loan accounts restructured during FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 under the COVID-19 Resolution Framework issued by the Reserve Bank of India vide its circulars dated August 6, 2020 and May 5, 2021, amounting to Rs.16,401.47 lakh. An additional provision of 10% was made on these assets over and above the normal provisioning requirements as at March 31, 2026. The balance outstanding in respect of such loans as at June 30, 2026 is Rs.13,947.63 lakh.



7. The Corporation has a property acquired against a defaulted loan with a value of Rs.400.34 Lakh shown as an asset in its Balance Sheet. This has been there for a very long time and there are no adequate records available to substantiate the recoverability of this asset.
8. The corporation has outstanding loan with the following major Public Sector Undertakings as on 30.06.2026.
- i. Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board (KIIFB)- Rs. 903.07 Crores.
 - ii. Kerala Social Security Pension Ltd (KSSP) - Rs. 2,000 Crores.
 - iii. Kerala Medical Services Corporation Ltd- Rs. 143.15 Crores.

These assets are not backed by any securities but are solely guaranteed by the Government of Kerala.
